## **Canoe / Camping Trip Packing List**

Use Waterproof Bags for packing: Big Ziploc Bags and Garbage Bags How to pack waterproof (if you don't have a waterproof or dry bag): Put the big garbage bag(s) (IT IS ALWAYS GOOD TO DOUBLE LAYER) into your duffel bag and put your gear and clothes in the Ziploc bags and put those bags in the giant garbage bag (do not put your stuff in the duffel bag and then try to put the garbage bag in, it doesn't work). Put duct tape on the bags for extra protection and if your bag rips.

NOTE: Any smellable items / snacks will need to go into the Bear Box at camp – Put all smellable items in a Ziploc Bag to put in the Bear Box
